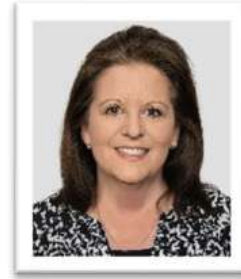

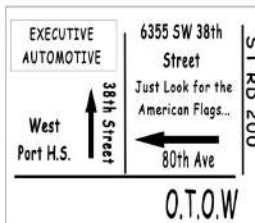

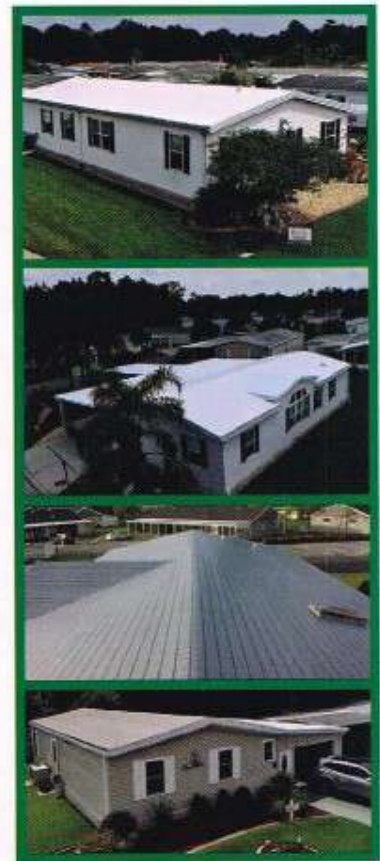

We have lived here since February and I've done my best to get involved with community events like Saturday coffee, monthly breakfast, café on bingo nights, the Halloween dance and the craft show.

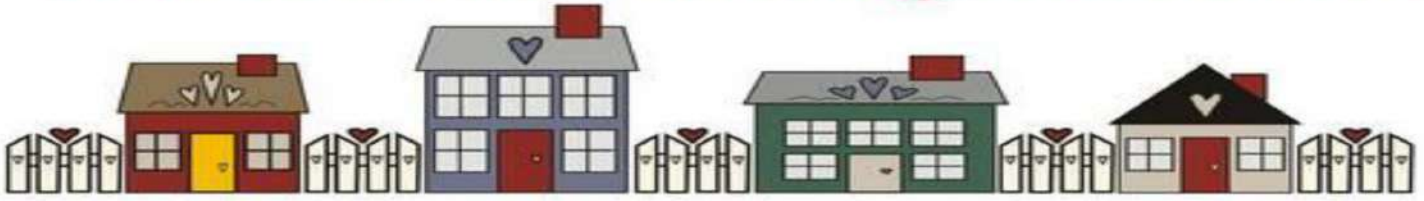

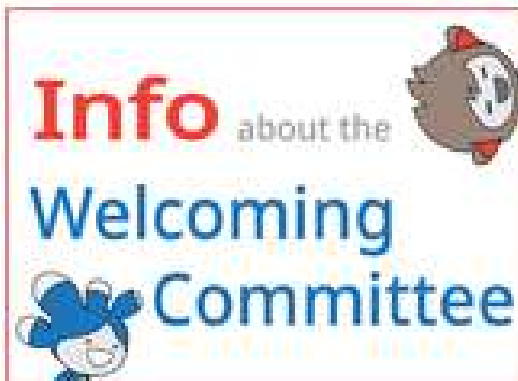
