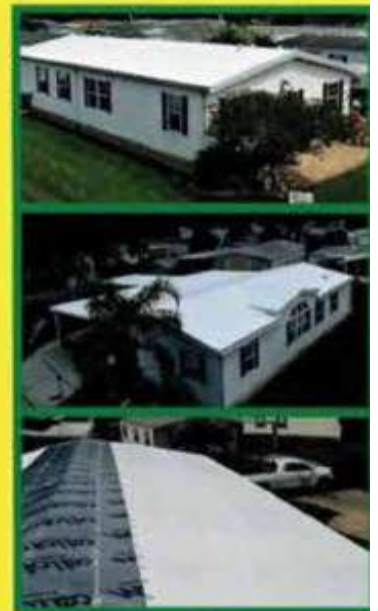

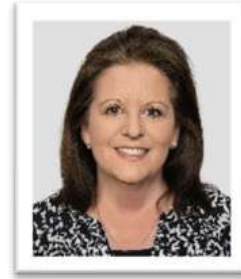

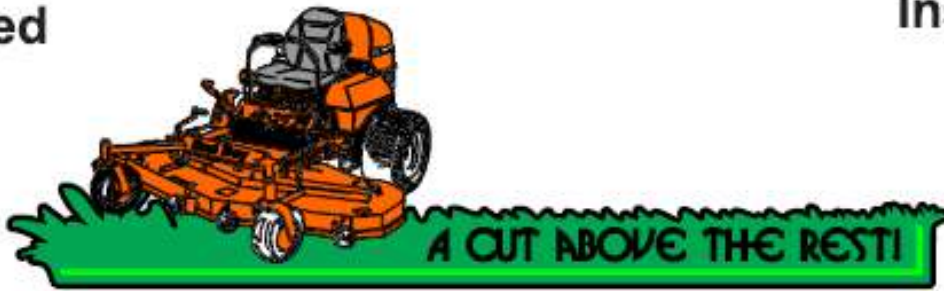

Hurricane Preparedness

With the news that a hurricane is on its way, it brings up the importance of being prepared. Saddle Oak Club would like you to know that the

Saddle Oak Clubhouse is *not* a designated Hurricane Shelter.

To find a **shelter** you may check the **Marion County Emergency Management Website**, listen to local radio or watch local TV channel 2 WESH. Please continue to check this website as the storm gets closer to find shelters that will be opened in our area as safe havens.

It's always a good idea to have a radio with fresh batteries to listen to updates. For radio updates on the storm you can listen to the *NOAA Weather radio*, this can be found on the following frequencies:

162.525 MHz out of Ocala or the same code for Marion County is 012083

**You can also access the NOAA radio on an app you can download on your Apple or Android phone or tablet.

MAKE SURE YOU ARE PREPARED!

Make sure you have the following things in case of a Severe Tropical Storm or Hurricane.

- Listen to a NOAA Weather Radio for critical information from the National Weather Service (NWS).
- Bring in anything that can be picked up by the wind (bicycles, lawn furniture).
- Close your windows, doors, hurricane shutters and awnings if you have them.
- Turn your refrigerator and freezer to the coldest setting. Keep them closed as much as possible so that food will last longer if the power goes out.
- Unplug small appliances.
- Fill your car's gas tank.
- Create a hurricane evacuation plan with members of your household and make sure you contact family members and let them know of your plans.
- Plan routes to local shelters, register family members with special medical needs and make plans for your pets to be cared for.
- Obey evacuation orders.*** Avoid flooded roads and washed out bridges.

***** We will put up a list of shelters in the clubhouse, when available, but it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to check to see which are open.**

***** If we are evacuated, and you choose not to leave, do not expect any emergency services to be able to come in to your aid.**

Hurricane Preparedness

REMEMBER – IF WE LOOSE POWER THERE WILL BE NO WATER OR SEWER SERVICES AVAILABLE

Recommended Hurricane Supplies

- Water—at least a 3-day supply; one gallon per person per day
- Food—at least a 3-day supply of non-perishable, easy-to-prepare food
- Flashlight
- Battery-powered or hand-crank radio (NOAA Weather Radio, if possible)
- Extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Medications (7-day supply) and medical items (hearing aids with extra batteries, glasses, contact lenses, syringes, etc.)
- Multi-purpose tool
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items
- Copies of personal documents (medication list and pertinent medical information, proof of address, deed/lease to home, passports, birth certificates, insurance policies)
- Cell phone with chargers
- Family and emergency contact information
- Extra cash
- Emergency blanket
- Map(s) of the area
- Pet supplies (collar, leash, ID, food, carrier, bowl)
- Tools/supplies for securing your home
- Extra set of car keys and house keys
- Extra clothing, hat and sturdy shoes
- Rain gear

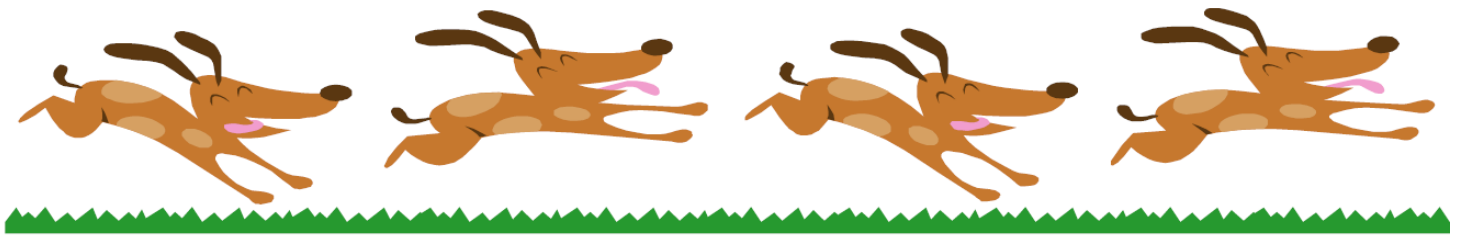

Prepare Your Pet

Now that hurricane season is upon us, you should consider the special needs of your best friend. If an evacuation emergency arises, Marion County has only one pet-friendly shelter, Vanguard High School. You should be aware of a few of their rules:

- You must provide proof of rabies vaccinations AND county license for your pet.
- Exotic animals, aggressive dogs, or animals weighing more than 80 pounds are NOT accepted.
- Owners must stay at the Vanguard shelter, but will not be housed in the same building as their pets.

Since your pet will be exposed to many other animals, you should be sure that all other immunizations and flea control are up to date, too. Consider a microchip for your pet. If lost, your pet can be electronically scanned anywhere in the US, and reunited with you based on the information from the chip. Many vets are equipped to microchip your dog (the fees vary). Marion County Animal Control will do the process for only \$15.

Other things to consider include:

- copies of important veterinarian records (medications, allergies, etc)
- a current picture of you with your pet (for identification and for others to search if you are separated from your pet)
- a spare non-retractable leash (can be used in many ways)
- a carrier or crate to house and protect the animal
- a favorite toy or two (to reduce stress)
- a supply of familiar food and water
- waste disposal (poop) bags
