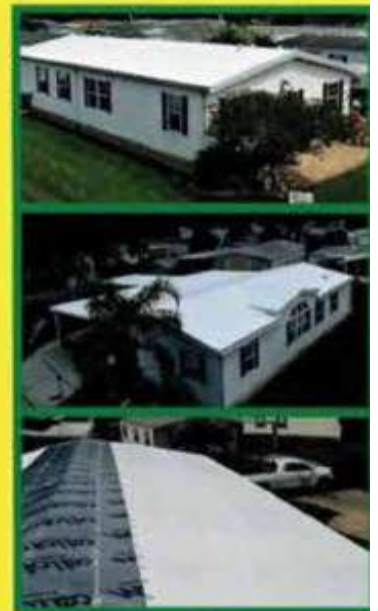

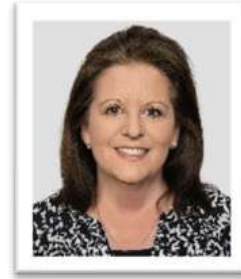

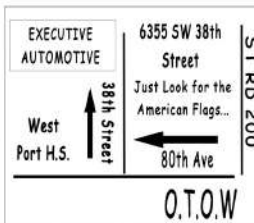

Sadly, we report the death of our longtime resident Fran Bolson Lot #227.



There are people who are considered “lifelong learners” and then there are the “lifelong volunteers”. Fran Bolson is someone who made volunteering a part of her normal routine, filling a need when one presents itself.

A 35-year SOC resident, Fran was the longest living resident. Fran and her husband, Philip, married for 58 years, began volunteering in Upstate New York by doing square dance calling and community theater. She was valedictorian of Proctor High School in Utica, NY and attended Kenka College. She was a member of a bowling team and secretary of the bowling league for 20 years.

Fran is the mother of twin daughters and a son; 4 grandchildren and a great-granddaughter living in upstate New York, Seattle, Australia and Orlando. At the age of 5, Fran sang on The Major Bowes Amateur Hour. She participated in local theater, ran several marathons beginning at age 69 (running a total of 80 different events). She was secretary to the VP of a candle company and also worked at Baldwinsville Methodist Church.

Fran brought her love of the arts, music, physical health and leadership skills to SOC. She and Phil continued volunteering when they moved to Saddle Oak and Fran continued after Philip’s passing. The following is an extensive list of volunteer activities Fran, and in some cases, Philip was involved at SOC. While Fran sold cards at Bingo, Phil served as caller. Other of her volunteer activities may be familiar because they are still being done: planned clubhouse socials, started line dancing, square dancing caller, started water fitness (aerobics), fashion shows, breakfast and dinner events, Saturday Night dances, newsletter editor, newsletter deliverer (newly retired), Telephone Committee, Welcoming Committee, Sunshine Committee, Saturday Coffee, Red Hats Society (Queen Mother), HOA President, HOA Secretary, Clubhouse Opener and Closer, Clubhouse Event Board Upkeep, member of the Glee Club, Drama Club, card games like bridge and pinochle, as well as being a chauffeur. Fran’s years of dedicated service to SOC would total 268 years! Fran was featured in the July 2022 newsletter edition for her volunteerism.

Many may recall her singing “It Had to Be You!” to open the Broadway Plus 2026 show at the clubhouse.

She organized SOC pinochle, sang in the church choir, and volunteered at West Marion Hospital where she has the distinct honor of accumulating over 8500 volunteer hours.

Fran’s quote(s) sums up pretty much her feelings on volunteering: “Volunteer! It does your heart good.” “I love to sing. I’ve been singing in the Presbyterian Church choir for 80 years.” “I loved all of the activities I volunteered for.” “I count my blessings every day.”
