DID YOU KNOW?

Parking in the RV lot is by permit only. Additional fees apply.

Speed limit throughout the park is 15 mph. If we each monitor our own, we won't need to complain about each other.

No hanging clothes or laundry are permitted outside, on the screened porches or near the home.

No parking on grass or patio. Registered guests may park near the bocce court.

Yard light posts are your responsibility.

2 registered "domesticated" pets per household. You must clean up after your pet. When outside all pets must be kept on hand held leash.

All homes must be adequately insured for liability including golf carts.

Guests should be accompanied by their resident host when using clubhouse, picnic area, shuffleboard, bocce court. No one under 18 years of age is permitted to use the billiard tables, bocce ball court, shuffleboard without the supervision of a resident or person over 18 years of age. Guests over the age of 18 may use the swimming pool unaccompanied providing they are pre-registered at the office.

No discharge of fire arms, air guns, BB guns within boundaries of SOC.

No soliciting.

Per Marion County Sheriff, you must possess a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart. (That means your grandchildren are probably not old enough to drive them.)

Per the Water Department, lawn watering days (2 per week) are scheduled by lot number. Do not water between 10 am and 4 pm. Lot watering schedule is posted in the Clubhouse.

The pool noodles do not belong to Sun Communities. When you borrow them from the storage box, please return them. Except for Margin Stout, your mother doesn't live here to pick up after you.

Garbage pick-up is NOT part of your lot rent. It is a separate fee payable to Waste Pro. Monday is garbage day, Wednesday is leaf/brush and recycle day and Thursday is trash day. Trash should not be placed curbside until after 7 pm day before pickup. Dumpster in the RV area is NOT for resident use.
