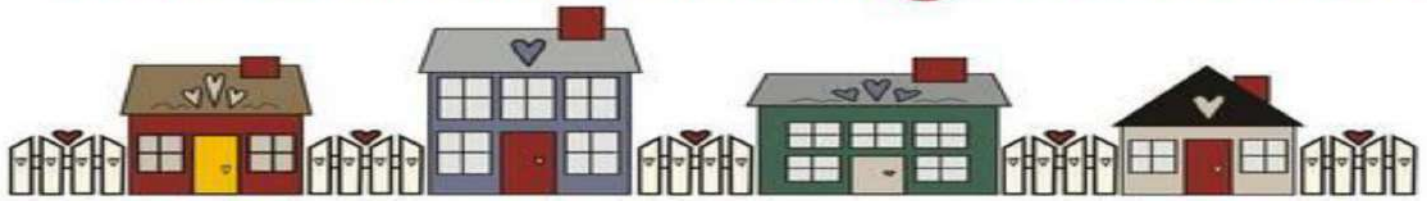
For New Residents

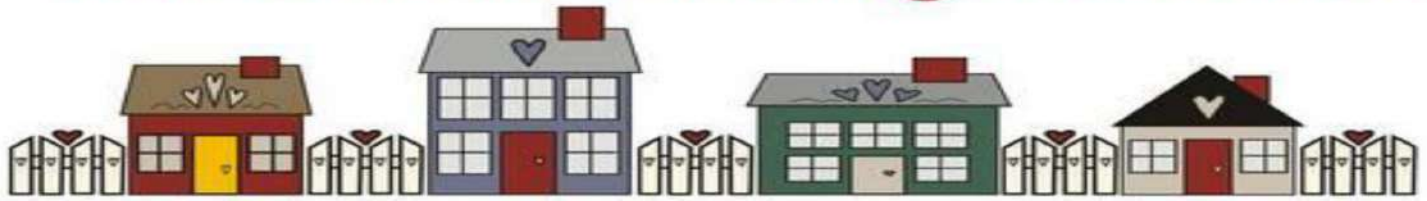

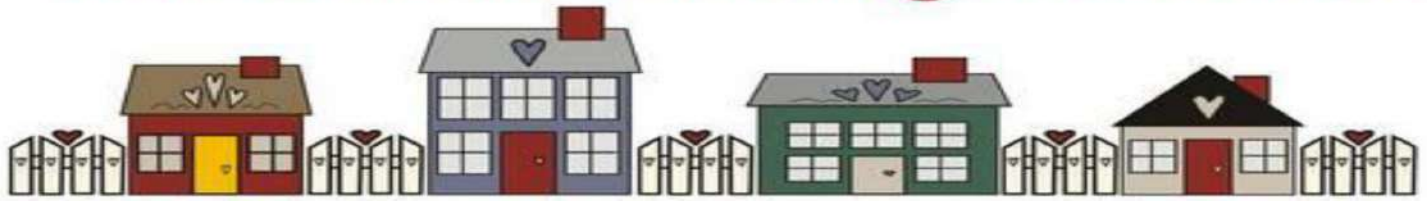
